This easy pieced table runner class is perfect for Quilting 101 graduates or any beginner that has basic rotary cutting and square/rectangle piecing experience. The next step in piecing is the triangle plus this runner includes a pieced border. A sample is on display at the shop.

The two session class is scheduled for Thu, **Mar 4** and **Mar 11**; day 2:00-4:00, evening 6:30-8:30. Cost is \$30 (includes pattern) paid at registration. Fabric purchased at Heritage for the class is 20% off. Leona Ragsdale is the instructor. Class size is limited. Registration deadline is Sat, **Feb 27**.

It has been shown that if you pay a fee you are more likely to reach your goal. Also, any product you buy for your UFQs through the year will be discounted at least 10%. At the end of 2010 each completed UFQ receives a Grand Prize Drawing ticket.

Pioneer Sampler BOM

The second meeting of this new block-of-the month will be Tue, **Feb 16** at 1:30 or 6:30. Attendance is not required so it is always fine to just pick-up the kits. The February block is "Rocky Mountain Puzzle". Now that you have paid the upfront costs you will only pay for the monthly kit; either \$9 or \$14. Remember, the cost of the monthly kits is an average for all 12 months. This means that all the fabric needed for the 12 blocks, borders, sashing and binding will be included in the monthly kit fee. When the year is over the only fabric you will need to purchase is backing and you will receive 20% off that cost if all 12 of your blocks have been assembled.

Quilt On A Barn

This is a six session fabric painting club. Each of the six quilt blocks will have a barn with a quilt painted on it's side. The first session was postponed a month and will now be held Sat, **Feb 20** from 11:00 - 3:00. At this time a few spots are still open. The cost is \$16 for each session with the first block to be paid when you sign-up. Sheryll Bentley is the instructor. She will supply the artwork designs, as well as the paint. Students are to supply six, 12 1/2" squares of background fabric (20% off if purchased at Heritage) and a mixed supply of brushes including flats, rounds and angled. If you are new to fabric painting you may wait to purchase your brushes until you have met with Sheryll. Also, one does NOT need to be artistic to participate and end up with awesome looking blocks!

Full instructions plus fabric for each block (1-2 per month) are provided, plus complete finishing instructions. This quilt is ideal for advanced beginners (those having completed at least one bed-size quilt) through experienced quilters. Finished quilt size: 87" x 92." Jenifer

Recipe of the Month

Oatmeal-Jam Squares

I used strawberry jam for this recipe, but it would be delicious with any flavor of jam or preserves.

- ½ cup butter, softened
- ½ cup brown sugar, packed
- ½ tsp. almond extract
- 1 cup flour
- ¼ tsp. baking soda
- 1 cup rolled oats
- 1 cup strawberry jam
- ¼ cup roasted-salted almonds, chopped

Preheat the oven to 350° or 325° if using a dark non-stick pan. Grease a 9x9” pan with shortening or butter and set aside. Combine the butter, brown sugar and almond extract in a medium-sized mixing bowl on medium speed until light and fluffy. Add the flour, baking soda and oats. Mix on low speed until well combined. Press 2 cups of the oat mixture onto the bottom of the prepared pan. Spread the jam over the top. Mix the remaining oat mixture with the chopped almonds. The color of the month is purple. Sprinkle the oat-nut mixture over the jam. Bake for 30-40 minutes or until the jam is bubbling and the topping begins to brown. Let the bars cool completely in the pan before slicing.

Makes 9-12 bars.

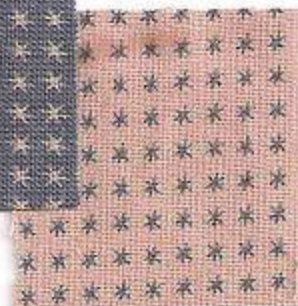
